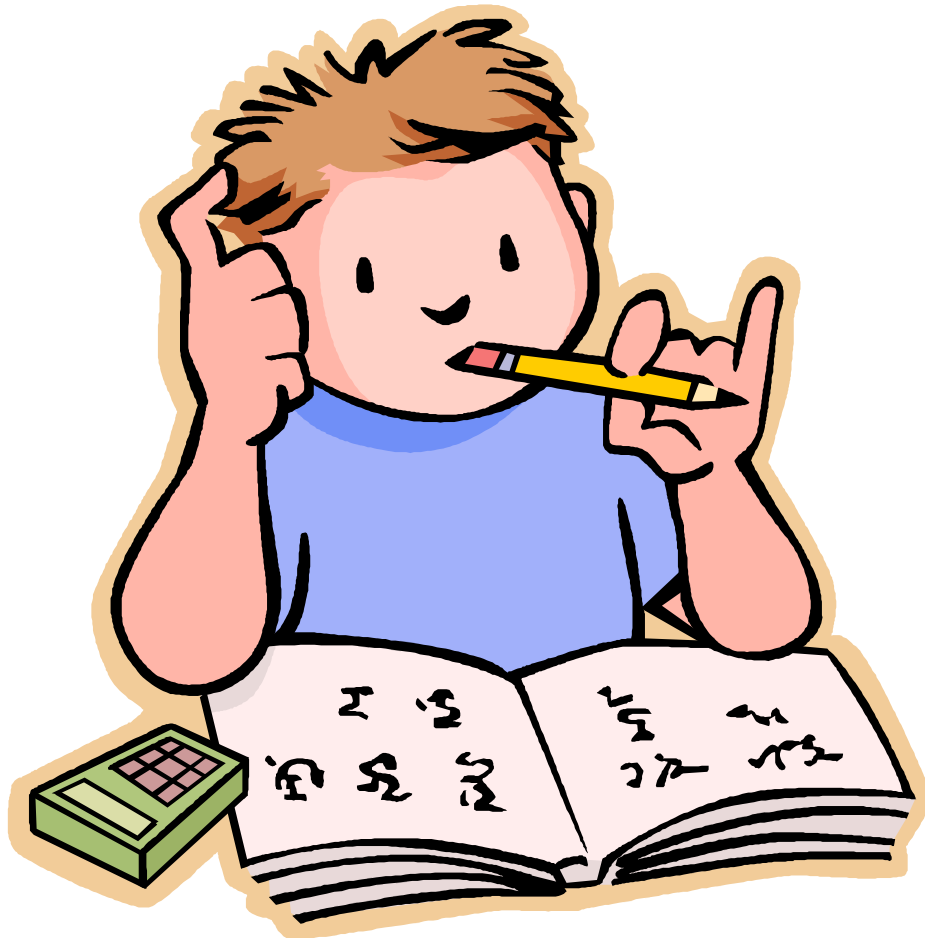

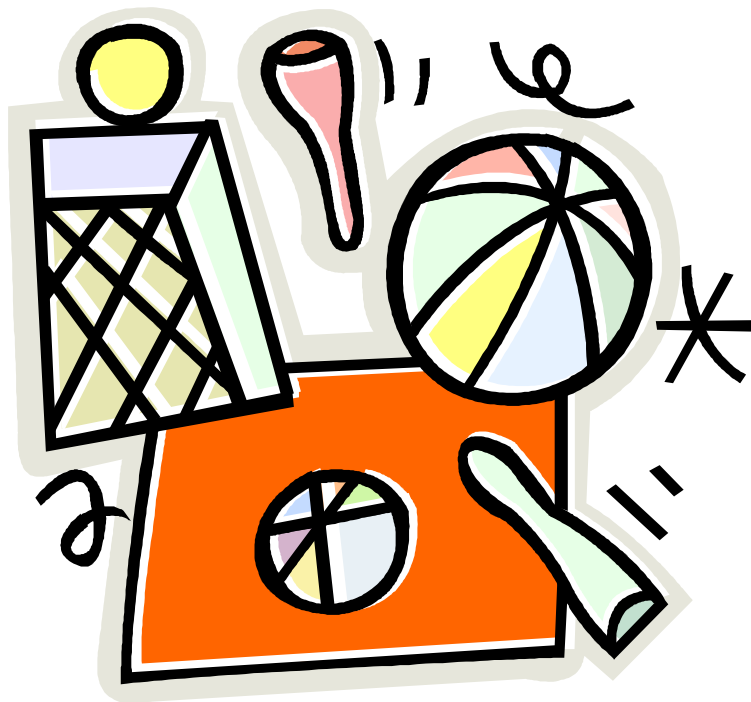

# **AFTER SCHOOL ACTIVITIES (A.S.A.) RULES**

Please read the following rules carefully!!!

## **I. PARTICIPANTS MUST BE ENROLLED IN THE BETH YESHURUN DAY SCHOOL**

**II.** The Fall After School Activities Program begins the week of January 4<sup>th</sup> and goes through May 27<sup>th</sup>. **Prices are based on the number of class days.** **Please remember that there are always more classes during the Spring Semester than the Fall Semester.** Please note important information below:

- **Registrations due December 6<sup>th</sup>**, and are based on a **FIRST COME FIRST SERVE BASIS**, bearing in mind that each class has a minimum and maximum number of children.
- A **\$25.00 per class late fee** (separate check please) must be paid for all registrations received **after December 5<sup>th</sup>**. Please make these checks payable to "Beth Yeshurun Day School". **Registrations will NOT be processed until the late fee is paid.**
- **Please note that A.S.A. classes will begin on the first day of school, January 4<sup>th</sup>, and will end on May 27<sup>th</sup>.**
- **Registration closes January 7<sup>th</sup>.**

## **III. PROCEDURES: LATE POLICIES / CAR POOL / MISSED CLASSES**

### **Three's & Pre-K:**

A.S.A. teachers go to the Early Childhood classrooms, pick up the children, and take them to A.S.A. classes. After each class, teachers return their students to the classrooms. At 2:00 p.m., teachers escort the children to carpool.

At 2:10 p.m., once carpool is over, **late charges** begin (unless you've made prior arrangements to pay EDC). (The charges are as follows: \$7.00 (B.Y. members) or \$7.50 (non members) per child per 15 minute increment.) Note that Three's and Pre-K children are not permitted to sit on the bench in the school lobby to wait for their rides.

### **K- 5<sup>th</sup> Grades:**

If your child's A.S.A. class ends at 3:00 p.m. or 3:15 p.m., your child goes to the Mandel Weiner Auditorium for carpool, unless you have registered them in Extended Day Care. If children are not picked up from carpool by 3:25 p.m., they go to E.D.C and late charges begin immediately (see above).

If the A.S.A. class ends after 3:30 p.m., you are required to pick up your child from his/her respective After School Activity classroom. The teacher will remain there for 5 minutes after the class ends, after which your child will be sent to E.D.C. and late charges begin immediately (see above).

### **Missed Classes/Carpool Changes:**

If your child will miss A.S.A. classes or has carpool changes occurring after these classes, please **send a note to the child's classroom teacher**, who will give it to Annie, the school receptionist. Annie will then pass the note along to Mireille Chait or Monique Turner. **Do not contact After School Activities regarding missed classes or carpool changes; Monique or Mireille may not receive the message in time.** If you have an emergency, call Annie (713-666-1884).

## **IV. PAYMENTS**

- Must be made in advance (by December 6<sup>th</sup>). Classes cost \$25.00 more, per class, after the deadline. **Late registrations will NOT be processed without late fees.**
  - Students who have not paid will not be allowed to attend classes.
  - (Exception: Do not pay for Study Hall until you are billed.)
- Must be made by check. **Cash will NOT be accepted.**
- Must be made out to the correct institution: See Page 25.
- Must NOT be written to After School Activities.
- Must NOT be combined. Please write separate checks, per child, per class. Otherwise, your checks will be returned to you!

### **Why do you have to write so many checks?**

Having separate checks allows us to input your information quickly. This method of payment also allows us to send checks directly to the various companies. **We WILL immediately deposit all checks for Tae Kwon Do, and classes taught by Beth Yeshurun teachers.**

## V. RETURNED CHECKS:

- There is a \$25.00 fee for returned checks.

## VI. REFUNDS

- If your child has enrolled for a class taught by an outside vendor, we will hold on to your check until he/she has taken the first class. The reason for this is that if your child wants to drop the class, we can return your check immediately. We will only hand your checks over to the respective vendors after the first week of A.S.A.

Once the second class begins, we do **NOT** provide refunds.

## **VII. DISCIPLINE POLICY**

**The Head of School is made aware of the situation. The ASA Coordinators will make another follow-up call to the parents in order to communicate that the student's behavior must improve or he/she will lose the privilege of continuing in the program.**

**CHANCE THREE:**  
3<sup>rd</sup> non-compliance

**The student will be dropped permanently from the class.**

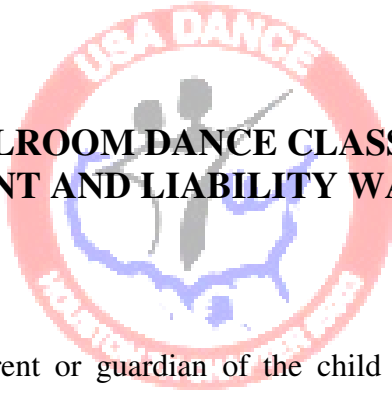

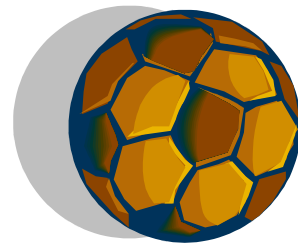
